5.	Cooption of new Councillor The cooption of Colleen Reichling as the new Parish Councillor to fill the seat left vacant by Cllr Kate Winston's retirement was proposed by Cllr Carter and seconded by Cllr Martin. The Council voted unanimously in favour and Cllr Reichling took her seat for the remainder of the meeting. Action: CP to circulate contact details.	
6.	 County and District Councillor's reports 6.1 County Council report Cllr Brain reported: 6.1.1 5 Year Land Supply – It has now been confirmed that the housing has been approved to meet identified needs for 6.75 years. This is good news for parishes hoping to avoid overdevelopment. 6.1.2 HGV Signage – Signs need to be corrected through Milcote and Clifford Chambers. 6.1.3 Barton Rd Junction – Installation of the replacement 	

bollard is still awaited.

- **6.1.4 Traveller's Caravan Pitches** Cllr Brain objected to increasing the number of pitches available but the Planning Inspector has agreed to increase to 14 pitches.
- **6.1.5 Councillor's Grant Scheme** This year's scheme is open for applications until October. Projects can include community groups or infrastructure such as signage, curbs etc.

6.2 District Council report

Cllr Barnes reported:

- 6.2.1 Neighbourhood Plan Welford's NDP has now been approved to go forward to referendum later in the year.
 Combined with the confirmed 5 year land supply, this will put Welford in a strong position when dealing with planning applications. Cllr Barnes thanked all those who have been involved in the production of the NDP since the process began, several years ago.
- 6.2.2 Weston House Our objection to the changes proposed for the Milcote Road junction were overruled at committee. The carriageway will be 5.1m. Deep concern was expressed by all present at the potential safety implications, particularly for pedestrians during peak traffic hours.

7. Planning

7.1 Approval of the Welford on Avon Neighbourhood Plan

The Parish Council are delighted that our Neighbourhood Plan has finally been approved by SDC. It will now go to referendum in October before being officially adopted but SDC have confirmed that in the meantime the majority of its content will still have 'significant weight' as a material consideration in planning decisions, with a small number of minor amendments to the text meaning those sections may carry 'moderate weight'. The Parish Council will produce an information leaflet to be circulated across the parish in advance of the referendum to summarise the key point of the plan and why it is so important that residents come out to vote in support.
