County and District Councillor's reports 5.1 District Councillors Report Cllr Barnes reported: New Homes in Long Marston – Developers require infrastructure improvements before plans can be agreed and the new bridge for the proposed bypass is still under discussion. However it should be noted that if approval is not given then SDC will struggle to meet their previously agreed 5 year land supply target. Changes to planning committee arrangements – Previously developments of 20+ houses had to go to committee. Under new rules these can be dealt with by the planners under delegated approval arrangements as long as the Parish and planners are in agreement. 			
	 5.2 County Councillors Report Cllr Brain reported: Speeding – While this continues to be an issue in many villages WCC have confirmed that this is not a priority area for 			

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	 spending. Parishes are free to look into funding local projects to address speeding. Coloured tarmac and rumble strips may be an option. Action: PC to consider options Width restriction at the Bell – While recognising the problems caused at this time of year by large agricultural vehicles travelling at speed through this narrow part of the highstreet it is unlikely that WCC will look to impose any restrictions of this nature because of the impact on local farmers who would be left with no direct route between their sites. Councillors Grant Scheme – The scheme is now accepting applications until 31st August.
