Welford-on-Avon Parish Council

Minutes of the Meeting held on Tuesday 2nd Feb 2021 at 7:15 p.m.

For the health and well-being of our community, as a result of the Covid-19 crisis and following the instruction of the Prime Minister's address on 23rd March 2020, all Parish Council meetings will be held remotely until further notice. Welford on Avon Parish Council will be using Zoom software to facilitate the holding of meetings. All meetings will be recorded using the Zoom software.

Public Participation:

Resident joined the meeting to raise their concerns regarding traffic and speeding through the village. They wished to understand what measures have been considered, which are still planned to be implemented and those which may have been discounted due to neighbourhood planning policies such as 'Dark Skies'. A constructive discussion followed between the resident, Parish and County Councillors, all of whom are keen to continue to make meaningful improvements to road safety in the village. The following actions were agreed:

Clerk to investigate with SDC Neighbourhood Development Plan group:

- what road safety improvements can be made under the existing NDP Dark Skies policy (can limited changes be made for safety reasons)?

- If a formal amendment is required for specific road safety features, obtain clarification on process & timings.

PC to revisit some of the alternative traffic calming measures that may not require lighting, eg white lines for road narrowing, rumble strips, mannequins, 20mph zone.

PC to complete the remaining approved traffic improvement features (incl new village gateways). Enlist support of Welford CSW and WCC Highways for traffic speed surveys to monitor their impact prior to instigating further work.

Cllr Brain to liaise with WCC Highways experts to assess feasibility of chicanes in Welford. Where would optimum location be taking into account the existing 2/3 chicanes (Binton Bridge, The Bell, Maypole Stores) and the Conservation Area setting? Request virtual meeting with PC to discuss.

Monitor the impact on traffic in Long Marston pre/post installation of chicanes.

	Station Works, Duchy Homes – Highways approval for Duchy to re-plant hedge so long as it doesn't obstruct visibility of road of signage.				
	Flooding – despite the heavy rain Welford appears to have suffered minimal impact on roads and homes. Clearance of debris at Binton bridges has helped. It was noted that surface water run-off from the fields into Pool Close is still a problem. Speak to land owner about clearing ditches.				
	Highways:				
	Barton Rd footpath restructuring work is completed. High Street will be next. First, High St residents need to cut back hedges where they have encroached over path. Action – PC to put notice to residents in Welford Matters.				
	Damaged grass verges – Cllr Brain to follow up with the Localities Officer to action				
	repairs on the following reported areas: Chapel St / Chapel Close – damage from refuse trucks. Cllr Brain to discuss with Biffa				
	Church St / Church Lane – as well as damage from HGV's, the verges in this area				
	have been significantly eroded in parts from heavy use and parking, over a foot of				
	verge has been lost in places. Once the verges have been re-established, Cllr Hockaday suggested using stone sets like those surrounding the churchyard to protect the verges opposite the church.				
	Duck Lane – Cllr Carter to contact Severn Trent as they cause damage.				
	It was noted that the Parish Council have received complaints from residents about the damage being done to the village verges which are protected green spaces.				
	Milcote Lane – lifted manhole cover, STW to address. Cllr Brain to look into 30mph repeater signs and/or roundel markings by the new development.				
	WCC have launched a £1mn Green Shoots Fund to support Climate Change. The scheme is open to local communities for a wide variety of projects.
