Insurance — To cover legal liability to Third Parties in the joint names of the County Council and Parish Council, was agreed.

WELFORD-ON-AVON COUNTY JUNIOR AND INFANTS' SCHOOL

Heads of Licence for use of field by the Welford-on-Avon Parish Council

1. The County Council

- (1) agree that the Parish Council shall have the use of the field
  - (i) on days when the school is open for instruction, but limited to the period from the end of school hours until lighting-up-time.
  - (ii) on days when the school is not open, from 9 a.m. until lighting-up-time.
- (2) will maintain the field in a reasonable state, reserving the right to close it for any period if in their absolute discretion they are of the opinion that it is necessary to do so to preserve the turf.

2. The Parish Council will

- (1) use their best endeavours to limit the use of the field to children of, or under, primary school age, i.e. up to eleven years.
- (2) pay a sum to be agreed to cover the extra cost of maintenance incurred by the County Council by reason of the Parish Council's use.
- (3) provide a proper entrance (with a gate suitable for pedestrians and perambulators) to the field direct from the road, which shall be their only means of access except as otherwise agreed.
- (4) clear the field each evening and lock their gate.
- (5) repay to the County Council one half of the premiums on an insurance to be effected with their Insurers in the joint names of the two Councils against third party claims arising out of the Parish Council's use of the field.

3. The arrangement to be for six months, after which the situation to be reviewed.
